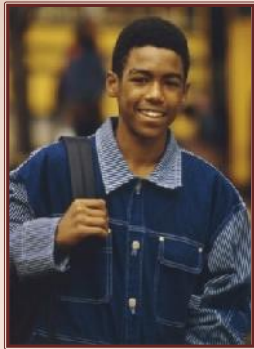


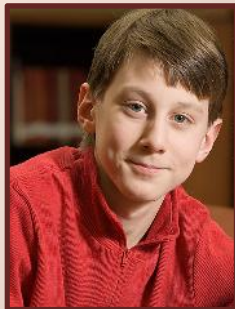
Mission Statement

Mentoring Studies Have Proven That

- Youth who are mentored are 46% less likely to use illegal drugs.
- Mentored youth develop a desire to improve their relationships with their peers and their parents.
- Mentored youth are less truant, feel more competent about their school work and do better in school.
- Mentored youth high school graduation rates improve.
- Mentored youth improve their sense of health and well-being; they feel valued and appreciated.



Training Structure

AYGMP training structure is designated into three distinct age appropriate groups. Participants fluently move through 3 hours of training each Saturday:

- 5th grade Elementary students
- Middle School students
- High School students

Academic Development

The academic components built into AYGMP strengthen the cognitive, analytical and critical thinking abilities of the mentee. The sessions are intense, yet they are age appropriate. Mentees will self-identify with their inherent talents, skills and abilities for it is our belief that every student has the potential to exceed their current academic and physical expectations. It is our mission to assist our mentees in developing exceptional abilities academically, physically and socially, while strengthening their ethics, morality and humility, as they journey through life and into manhood.

Each mentee is expected to attend all 16 sessions and participate in martial arts classes during each session.
